

Tech Study UK – AI & Machine Learning Summer Camp Terms & Conditions

These Terms & Conditions apply to students attending the **AI & Machine Learning Summer Camp** held from **2nd to 16th August 2026** by Tech Study UK LTD (“Summer Camp”).

1. Definitions

- i. **‘Acceptance’** means Tech Study UK sends the Student an email confirming they have been accepted onto the Summer Camp.
- ii. **‘Application’** means submitting an application on the Tech Study UK website (www.techstudyuk.co.uk).
- iii. **‘Business day’** means Monday to Friday.
- iv. **‘Campus’** means any facilities hired by Tech Study UK for the Summer Camp.
- v. **‘Commencement Date’** means the start date of the AI & Machine Learning Summer Camp, **2nd August 2026**.
- vi. **‘Contract’** means the legally binding agreement between Tech Study UK and the Student once the Student has been Accepted, including these Terms & Conditions and other referenced documents.
- vii. **‘Intellectual Property Rights’** means copyright, designs, patents, trademarks, trade names, domain names, goodwill, and all other intellectual property rights, whether registered or not, including applications, renewals, or extensions.
- viii. **‘Tech Study UK’** means Tech Study UK LTD, a company incorporated in England (registration number 13553042) with its registered address at 235–239 High Road, Asley House Suite 404, London, United Kingdom, N22 8HF.
- ix. **‘Rules & Regulations’** means all of Tech Study UK’s Rules & Regulations linked in the Appendix.
- x. **‘Summer Camp’** means the AI & Machine Learning Summer Camp held **in-person at the University of Surrey from 2nd to 16th August 2026**, as described on the Tech Study UK website.
- xi. **‘Student’** means the student and, where under 18, includes their parent(s) or guardian.
- xii. **‘Student Data’** means any Personal Data provided to Tech Study UK as part of the Application, Student Information Form, or participation in the Summer Camp, processed under the Data Protection Policy.
- xiii. **‘Student Content’** means any content created or provided by the Student during the Summer Camp, including on the Platform, which must comply with the Rules & Regulations.
- xiv. **‘Student Information Form’** means the required form the Student must complete before the Commencement Date.
- xv. **‘VAT’** means value-added tax under the Value Added Tax Act 1994.
- xvi. **‘Graduate’** means the Student successfully completes and graduates from the Summer Camp, including the Graduation event, certificate, and where applicable, tutor report or recommendation letter.
- xvii. **‘Content’** means educational live or recorded video, audio, or written material provided by Tech Study UK Tutors.
- xviii. **‘Tutor’** means any tutor, mentor, speaker, or staff member of Tech Study UK.

2. Application and Student Information Form

- i. By submitting an Application, the Student confirms they have read and agree to this Contract, which becomes binding upon Acceptance.

- ii. The Student must be aged **15–21** at the start of the Summer Camp, unless otherwise agreed in writing.
- iii. The Student must declare any **medical, dietary, or special needs** on the Application or Student Information Form so that reasonable arrangements can be made.
- iv. If the Student fails to submit the Student Information Form, or provides incomplete or inaccurate information, Tech Study UK cannot be held responsible for any resulting issues or omissions.

3. Acceptance

- i. Acceptance onto the Summer Camp is at the sole discretion of Tech Study UK following review of the Application and personal statement.
- ii. A Student's place is **not confirmed** until the **non-refundable deposit** is paid (unless awarded a written scholarship).
- iii. Tech Study UK reserves the right to withdraw an offer or terminate the Contract if the Application is found to be inaccurate or incomplete.

4. Payment

- i. Fees include VAT where applicable. For invoices issued **within the UK**, a **20% VAT** will be added.
- ii. Payment can be made **only in British Pounds (GBP)** by **bank transfer or credit card**. A **4% processing fee** applies to credit card payments (bank transfers are exempt). Students should note that some banks may charge additional transfer fees or apply exchange rate differences.
- iii. All payments must be made in full, without deduction or withholding.

5. Cancellations by Student

- i. If cancellation is made **on or before 15th February 2026**, Tech Study UK will refund the full balance paid, excluding the deposit.
If cancellation occurs **between 16th February and 15th May 2026**, a **50% refund** of the balance (excluding deposit) will be issued.
If cancellation occurs **between 16th May and 31st May 2026**, a **10% refund** of the balance (excluding deposit) will be issued.
No refunds will be issued for cancellations **on or after 1st June 2026**.
 - ii. Refunds will be processed within **30 days** of written notice.
 - iii. All cancellations must be **submitted in writing**.
 - iv. Cancellations outside these terms, including illness or visa issues, are not refundable. Students are advised to arrange insurance to cover such eventualities.
- Note:** The deposit is strictly non-refundable.

6. Termination

Tech Study UK reserves the right to terminate the Contract without refund if:

- a) Full payment has not been received within 15 days of invoice.
- b) The Student fails to complete the Student Information Form 30 days before the Camp, or provides inaccurate information.
- c) The Student fails to notify Tech Study UK of changes to their details.
- d) The Student is deemed medically unfit.

e) The Student behaves unacceptably, violates Rules & Regulations, or UK law. In such cases, the Student will **not be allowed to graduate, attend the ceremony, or receive any certificate or tutor report.**

7. Insurance

Students must arrange **comprehensive insurance** covering health, travel, course fees, and personal belongings. Proof of insurance must be brought to the Camp. Tech Study UK is not responsible for expenses arising from cancellations, theft, medical treatment, or accidents.

8. Visa

Students are responsible for obtaining the correct **UK visa** for study during the Camp. No refunds will be issued for visa-related failures to attend.

9. Medication

Students are responsible for administering and storing their own prescribed medication. Tech Study UK will only provide basic first aid and over-the-counter medicine (e.g., paracetamol) unless opted out in writing.

10. Limitation of Liability

Tech Study UK is not liable for any **loss, damage, theft, or injury**, except for cases of proven negligence under English law. Students are advised to have insurance. Tech Study UK is not responsible for losses due to external factors such as third parties or force majeure events.

11. Student Responsibilities

Students agree:

- To abide by **UK law** and Tech Study UK's Rules & Regulations.
- To behave **considerately, responsibly, and cooperatively** towards tutors, staff, and peers.
- To care for facilities and property, avoiding damage or misuse.
- Not to post or share content about Tech Study UK, its staff, or students without written permission.
- To follow **road safety** and **COVID-19** policies.
- To grant Tech Study UK permission to use non-personal content or images for **educational or promotional** purposes unless opted out in writing.

12. Graduation

To graduate, the Student must:

- Attend all required sessions;
- Submit all required work;
- Avoid plagiarism;

- Not have been dismissed or disciplined.
Tech Study UK may withdraw certificates or reports if post-Camp breaches are discovered.

13. Notices

All notices must be in English or Turkish, sent by email or courier, and will be considered delivered when successfully sent or after five business days if mailed.

14. Data Protection

Tech Study UK complies with the **General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)** and the **Data Protection Act 2018**, as outlined in its Data Protection Policy.

15. Force Majeure

Tech Study UK is not liable for failure to perform due to causes beyond its control, including but not limited to power failure, natural disasters, pandemics, or government restrictions. If a Force Majeure event cancels the Camp, no refund is due, but Tech Study UK may offer an alternative session where feasible.

16. Recordings & Promotional Activities

Sessions may be recorded for quality or promotional purposes. Students who do not consent should notify Tech Study UK in writing and keep their camera off. Quotes or feedback may be used for future promotional materials unless declined in advance.

17. Lost Property

Tech Study UK **cannot** be held responsible for lost items. Lost property will be kept for **8 weeks** and then donated or destroyed.

18. General

- Nothing in this Contract creates a partnership between Tech Study UK and the Student.
- Amendments must be in writing and signed by both parties.
- Tech Study UK may modify Camp content, tutors, or schedules as needed.
- These Terms & Conditions are governed by the **laws of England and Wales**, with exclusive jurisdiction in its courts.
